This book helps the reader understand how the parts of the eye work together so we can see and also investigate the tools and technology that help us see more clearly.

After reading and discussing the book, play Eye Jeopardy with your class. Set the Jeopardy game up and divide your class into teams. Assign a \$ value to each question beginning with \$200. (\$200, \$400, \$600, \$800)
